Among many other things, we've successfully raised significant funds to enable us to make several improvements and upgrades inside of our building including installation of automatic no-touch door openers (just wave your hand!), plexiglass dividers, and automatic no-touch lighting, sinks, soap dispensers, and toilets/urinals.**

We are just beginning replacement of flooring throughout our facility!

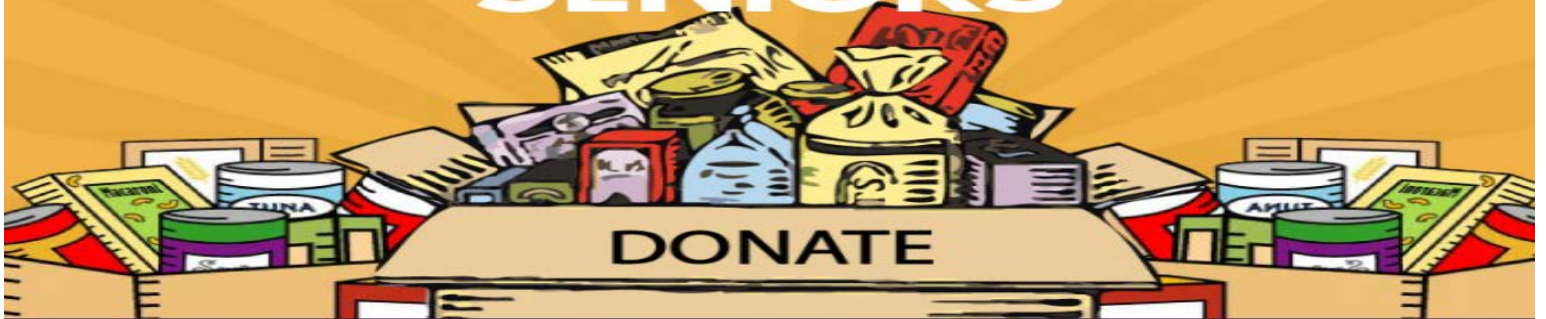
In addition to the small areas we've previously replaced, we'll now be able to also replace the remaining 16-year-old carpeting.

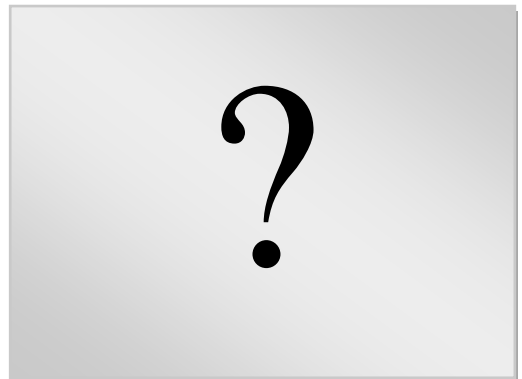
