WCASC is proud to announce that we have now surpassed distributing OVER 210,000 + MEALS to our seniors!

That's right! Since COVID-19 forced our closure in March 2020, we've sourced, sorted, organized, and distributed **MORE THAN Five TIMES** the food we served the year prior to hundreds of seniors in need in our community!

In addition to our ongoing Food Distribution program, we also continue to offer virtual programming and support to our seniors in many different ways. Among many other things, we've successfully raised significant capital funds to enable us to make several improvements and upgrades inside of our building including installation of all new floors, state of the art air purifiers, automatic no-touch door openers (Just wave your hand!), plexiglass dividers, and automatic no-touch lighting, sinks, soap dispensers, and bathroom fixtures.

You've also seen our recent wonderful news of the creation of our new "Corner Cabinet" which will serve as our Center's permanent food distribution center!

COVID-19's Omicron variant's significant spike in Chester County that still has us in the "High" transmission category has caused us to delay our previously hoped for reopening but we are still hoping to welcome you back soon.

Isolation

Used for

People with confirmed or suspected COVID-19

Why

To keep the person from infecting others

Where

Could be at home, a health care facility, or an isolation location



Quarantine

Used for

People who were potentially exposed to COVID-19 and who are not sick

Why

- The person could have the virus in their body even without symptoms
- To quickly identify early symptoms

Where

Could be at home or a quarantine location
